WHAT IS THE NORTH SHORE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE?

NSCOC is a private, non-profit organization. We work toward planned, appropriate, and sustainable economic development that serves both residents and visitors alike. We are committed to protecting the rural character of the North Shore. Both individuals and businesses may join our organization, which operates primarily on volunteer energy and tax-deductible donations. Monies are raised through membership dues, donations, grants and fundraising activities.

WHAT DOES THE NORTH SHORE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE DO?

Since its inception in 1989 when we were incorporated as Haleiwa Main Street (HMS), we have actively worked to uphold the Haleiwa Special District, beautify Haleiwa Town (Weed Circle), support the business community to encourage sustainable economic development and promote Haleiwa and the North Shore through special events (Sunset on the Beach and Annual Christmas Parade) and media promotions. HMS successfully led the North Shore's efforts to redesign the Haleiwa Bypass entrance and install signs along the bypass and at the entrance of the town to attract visitors. HMS was also instrumental in the restoration of the historic Waialua District Court House, the Anahulu Bridge, and development of a Historic Walking Tour of the town. In 2002, the name was changed to DBA North Shore Chamber of Commerce to include the whole North Shore community. The Chamber completed restoration of the Mutual Telephone Company building for its new home in 2010 and currently operates the visitor information & business resource center with historical display from there. The Chamber acts in an advocacy role on behalf of North Shore business. Current projects include working with the City to make Haleiwa Town a safe, pedestrian-friendly place; preserving the history of the area, representing the North Shore on the Oahu Metropolitan Planning Organization; realignment of Kamehameha Hwy. at Laniakea/Chun's, and sponsoring such events as the annual Business Expo, Christmas Party, and Christmas Parade as well as monthly Art Walk.
