## WHAT IS THE NORTH SHORE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE?

NSCOC is a private, non-profit organization. We work toward historic preservation, improvement and beautification of the area, marketing, and planned, appropriate, and sustainable economic development that serves both residents and visitors alike. We are committed to protecting the rural character of the North Shore. Both individuals and businesses may join our organization, which operates primarily on volunteer energy and tax-deductible donations. Monies are raised through membership dues, donations, grants and fundraising activities.

## WHAT DOES THE NORTH SHORE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE DO?

Since its inception in 1989 when we were incorporated as Haleiwa Main Street (HMS), we have actively worked to uphold the Haleiwa Special District, beautify Haleiwa Town, increase economic activity and promote Haleiwa and the North Shore through special events and media promotions. HMS successfully lead the North Shore’s efforts to redesign the Haleiwa Bypass entrance and install three signs along the bypass and at the entrance of the town to attract visitors. HMS was also instrumental in the restoration of the historic Waialua District Court House and developed a Historic Walking Tour of the town. In 2002, the name was changed to DBA North Shore Chamber of Commerce to include the whole North Shore community.

Current projects include working with the City to beautify and make Haleiwa Town a pedestrian-friendly place by constructing walkways from Weed Circle to the Boat Harbor and Haleiwa Beach Park. We are also in the process of improving our website for the North Shore and Haleiwa.
