The Telephone Exchange Building was donated to the North Shore Chamber of Commerce by the owners of Ace Hardware to ensure its future in Haleiwa. This historic landmark was relocated to the grounds of the Waiialua Community Association June of last year and must now be restored.

Please join us in preserving the building's historic and architectural integrity, while developing it into an information center with historical display and new home for the North Shore Chamber of Commerce.

The Historic Telephone Exchange Building is one of 30 historical buildings on Haleiwa Main Street dating back to the early 1900s and protected under the Haleiwa Historic District.

Built in 1924, the building is the site from which direct dialing to Honolulu was made possible in 1953. It is listed with the State Historic Preservation Office, and is eligible to be listed on the State and National Registers of Historic Places.

With its hip-and-gable roof and flared walls, the single-story building is representative of the plantation-era architecture that gives Haleiwa Town its unique North Shore aesthetic.
